In 2020, a group of curious people met regularly to explore VR- and 3D-worlds with the emphasize on virtual meetings and events. In 2021, the journey of the #VRExplorer team continues; now testing new tools.

Our approach is to test new possibilities for online meetings and collaboration. While the world got used to meet in 2D-tools like Zoom, Webex, MS Teams etc. during the pandemic, we think the next step will follow soon: To gather, communicate and collaborate in VR- and 3D-environments.

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While we carry the term "VR" already in our name, we don't exclude 3D solutions at all.

Why? Because the use of VR tools is still linked to special hardware like VR headsets; equipment not every company or person can easily afford to buy.

For that, 3D tools are a welcome alternative: No extra equipment, mostly running on desktops/ mobile devices, and due to easy handling providing a low barrier of entry to use.

GLUE

3D

GLUE has the mission to "help people and teams around the world collaborate in more human, productive and sustainable ways".

Eleven different settings offer multiple facilities to enable different collaboration scenarios such as office spaces and meeting areas for collaboration. The beach set-up allows a more informal gathering and private conversations "under water". Spatial audio provides a natural understanding of where the other users are around.

While using Glue via desktop already allows a lot of interaction like picking up things and playing games like chess and backgammon, the VR version comes with lip sync, eye contact and gestures via the controllers.

Whiteboard with drawing function, sticky notes and embedding 3D objects are available in the desktop version. The VR version additionally allows 3D drawing.

The avatars have a human appearance and can be customized with gender, hairstyle, make-up, clothing etc. Navigation on the touchpad or via mouse is easy and intuitive.

In the free version, all settings are available for up to ten users for a maximum of 30 minutes, then the session has to be re-entered.

Accessibility: A client needs to be installed on the desktop to enter Glue.

Administration: One owner is needed to set up the team spaces and invite the team members. Within Glue, all users are having the same rights and possibilities.

GLUE Pros and Cons

- Free version offers the full environment with 11 different rooms/settings
- Great graphics/resolution and audio
- When logging out, rooms will remain as left
- Needs less bandwidth than a usual videoconference, as no video streaming is needed
- When using a VR headset, lipsync, eye contact and gestures can be noticed
- Lots of external tools (Miro, Mural, Browser etc.) can be integrated; 3D objects available
- Clear menu, navigation and intuitive control (the escape-button is the trick!)
- Whiteboard with drawing function and sticky notes available
- Mixed use PC/VR headset works well
- Different games available (chess, dices, etc.)

Client has to be downloaded

CONS

- Free version offers 30 minutes of using, then you have to log in again
- Spatial audio zones only available in meeting rooms
- When using PC, the use of sticky notes is tricky as they cannot be anchored to an object
- Integration of external tools is still work in progress, and we had varied results in our testing
